## The Art of Italy Fall 2025 Semester

**Tuesday: Beginning October 14, 11:30AM- 1:00PM**

*This 5-session course is designed to explain, in depth, about the history and social context of the great works of Italian art.*

The instructor, Professor Robert Geronimo is an instructor at The College of Staten Island and a published illustrator, writer, and comic creator. The course is designed to show, by means of slides and lectures, the development of art in Italy in relation to the rest of Europe and offers students an introduction to the most important artistic styles (Ancient Roman, Medieval, Renaissance, and Baroque).
